RESOLUTION NO. 196

A RESOLUTION of the City of Redmond, Washington, endorsing in principle the program and objectives of Forward Thrust for the Seattle-King County area.

WHEREAS, an area-wide development program has been proposed by the Forward Thrust organization to be submitted for voter approval on February 13, 1968, dealing with urban growth problems and providing measures for environmental improvement to meet the needs of the rapidly increasing population of the Seattle-King County area, to prevent urban blight, and to enhance human qualities and values; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has examined the propositions to be submitted to the voters of this area and finds that the Forward Thrust program should be endorsed and supported as being for the public benefit and welfare; Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, That the program and objectives of the Forward Thrust propositions and measures to^{be} submitted for voter approval in the Seattle-King County area on February 13, 1968, are hereby endorsed in principle and are supported as being for the public benefit and welfare of the citizens of the City of Redmond and environs.
