A RESOLUTION, fixing the time and place for a public hearing to be held before the City Council upon a Petition for the Vacation of a portion of 164th Avenue N.E.

WHEREAS, a written Petition for Vacation of Street has been filed with the City Clerk and presented to the City Council January 16, 1968, requesting that the City Council vacate that certain street and public way lying within the limits of the City of Redmond, described as follows:


That portion of unimproved 164th Avenue N.E. abutting on the West side of 4 & 5 of plat of Miravista as recorded in Vol. 28, page 13, records of King County, Washington.

That the date of March 5, 1968, at the hour of 8:00 P.M., is hereby fixed as the date and time for a public hearing on said Petition for Vacation of Street to be held at the City Hall before the City Council; and that the City Clerk give due and proper notice of such hearing in the manner required by law.
