

ORDINANCE NUMBER 2Ordinance fixing time of meetings of the Town Council  
and providing for attendance upon the same.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Redmond,  
that regular meetings of the Council shall be held on ~~the~~ each  
Wednesday at 8 P.M. at ~~of each month at~~ Waether  
Hotel and special meetings of the Council  
may be called at any time by the Mayor or by three Councilmen  
by written notice delivered to each member at least three hours  
before the time specified for the proposed meeting. A majority  
of the Councilmen shall constitute a quorum but a less number  
may adjourn from time to time and at any such meeting may notify  
all absent members to be present at the time to which said meet-  
ing is adjourned, and that in the event of their failure so to do  
they shall be subject to a penalty of Five ~~X~~ \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars  
and upon any such absent member receiving said notice and failing  
to attend said penalty of Five ~~X~~ \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars shall be  
assessed against him and if the same is not paid, shall be  
collected in the court of any Justice of the Peace having juris-  
diction thereof.
