## ORDINANCE NO. 2012

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND. WASHINGTON, RELATING TO THE RIDING OF BICYCLES ON SIDEWALKS, AMENDING RMC 10.10.020 IN ORDER TO ADD WAC 308-330-555 TO THE LIST OF MODEL TRAFFIC ORDINANCE SECTIONS NOT ADOPTED BY THE CITY. AMENDING RMC 10.48.040(a) IN ORDER TO EXEMPT POLICE PATROLS FROM THE PROHIBITION AGAINST RIDING BICYCLES ON SIDEWALKS IN THE CITY CENTER ZONE, **PROVIDING** FOR **SEVERABILITY** ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, WAC 308-330-555, which is part of the Model Traffic Ordinance adopted by Section 10.10.010 of the Redmond Municipal Code, prohibits riding bicycles on sidewalks in business districts and duplicates Section 10.48.040 of the Redmond Municipal Code, and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to repeal the duplicative regulation from the Model Traffic Ordinance and further desires to amend the Redmond Municipal Code in order to exempt police patrols from the prohibition on riding bicycles on sidewalks, NOW, THEREFORE.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. MTO Sections Not Adopted. Section 10.10.020 of the Redmond Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

10.10.020 Sections of Model Traffic Ordinance Not Adopted. The

following sections of the Model Traffic Ordinance, and any state statutes adopted therein by reference, are not adopted by reference and are expressly deleted from the Redmond Municipal Code:

WAC 308-330-250 WAC 308-330-322 WAC 308-330-500 WAC 308-330-505 WAC 308-330-510 WAC 308-330-520 WAC 308-330-525 WAC 308-330-530 WAC 308-330-535 WAC 308-330-540 WAC 308-330-555

Section 2. Riding on Sidewalk. Subsection 10.48.040(a) of the Redmond Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

- (a) No person shall ride a bicycle upon a sidewalk within the city center zone as designated on the official city zoning map, except that:
- (1) bicycles may be ridden on any sidewalk which has been designated a combination sidewalk/bike lane in accordance with Section 10.48.035; and
- (2) this prohibition shall not apply to police personnel while engaged in the performance of their official duties.

Section 3. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance, being an exercise of a power specifi-

cally delegated to the City legislative body, is not subject to referendum, and shall take effect five (5) days after passage and publication of an approved summary thereof consisting of the title.
