The Wang Property is downhill from the Strom Property which is downhill from Greystone along 159<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE. The existing manhole #3CSMH10 invert elevation is 213.43-feet(reference attached plan). The Wang house sits at approximately elevation 180-feet. A gravity connection to the existing manhole will not function. Any development on the Wang Property will require grinder pumps with force mains uphill to the gravity system or a new gravity system will be designed and constructed downhill to NE 124<sup>th</sup> Avenue.

Water supply to both properties can be provided by extending an 8-inch diameter water main north in 159<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE.

Dry utilities such as gas, power, and cable are not a City of Redmond operated utility. PSE needs to be contacted to set up connections for these services. 159<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE could provide the necessary right-of-way.
