CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON RESOLUTION NO. 202

A RESOLUTION, declaring the intention of the City Council of the City of Redmond to order the formation of a utility local improvement district for the construction of water system improvements in the Viewpoint area on the Bellevue-Redmond Road, N.E. 40th Street, 172nd Avenue N.E., N.E. 36th Street, 177th Avenue N.E., 175th Avenue N.E., and N.E. 38th Street; and fixing a date for a public hearing thereon.

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is in the best public interest of the City of Redmond and is necessary for the public peace, safety and welfare that water system improvements be constructed and installed in the Viewpoint area of the City on the Bellevue-Redmond Road, N.E. 40th Street, 172nd Avenue N.E., N.E. 36th Street, 177th Avenue N.E., 175th Avenue N.E., and N.E. 38th Street, consisting of the construction and installation of water main extensions and necessary water system appurtenances to serve the properties benefited by the improvements within an utility local improvement district hereafter described; and

WHEREAS, the City Council having further determined that said improvements should be paid in whole or in part by the levy and collection of assessments upon the property within the proposed improvement district, such assessments being for the sole purpose of payment into a revenue bond fund established for the payment of revenue bonds issued to defray the cost of such improvements; and that a date for a public hearing thereon should be fixed; NOW, THEREFORE.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO RESOLVE as follows:

Section 1. The City Council hereby declares its intention to order the formation of an utility local improvement district for the construction and installation of water system improvements, consisting of water main extensions and additions to the Viewpoint Water System, on the following streets:

(1) <u>Bellevue-Redmond Road</u> - Construction of a six-inch water main and appurtenances from the intersection of the Bellevue-Redmond Road (AKA County Road No. 1387) with West

Lake Sammamish Parkway N.E. southeasterly along the Belle-vue-Redmond Road to an intersection with N.E. 40th Street.

(2) N.E. 40th Street - Construction of a six-inch water main and appurtenances from the intersection of N.E. 40th Street with the Bellevue-Redmond Road (AKA County Road 1387) east along N.E. 40th Street to an intersection with West Lake Sammamish Parkway N.E. (AKA SR-901).

(3) 172nd Avenue N.E. - Construction of a ten-inch water main and appurtenances from the intersection of 172nd Avenue N.E. with West Lake Sammamish Parkway N.E. (AKA SR-901) south along 172nd Avenue N.E. to an intersection with N.E. 30th Street.

(4) N.E. 36th Street - Construction of an eight-inch water main and appurtenances from the intersection of N.E. 36th

- (4) N.E. 36th Street Construction of an eight-inch water main and appurtenances from the intersection of N.E. 36th Street with 172nd Avenue N.E. east along N.E. 36th Street to an intersection with West Lake Sammamish Parkway N.E. (AKA SR-901).
- (5) 177th Avenue N.E. Construction of a six-inch water main and appurtenances from the intersection of 177th Avenue N.E. with West Lake Sammamish Parkway N.E. (AKA SR-901) south along 177th Avenue N.E. to a point opposite the south line of Tract No. 5, Harrison's Acreage Tracts.
- (6) N.E. 40th Street 175th Avenue N.E. N.E. 38th Street Construction of an eight-inch water main and appurtenances from the intersection of N.E. 40th Street with West Lake Sammamish Parkway N.E. east along N.E. 40th Street to an intersection with 175th Avenue N.E., and thence southeast-erly along 175th Avenue N.E. to an intersection with N.E. 38th Street, and thence west along N.E. 38th Street to an intersection with West Lake Sammamish Parkway N.E. (AKA SR-901).
- (7) N.E. 40th Street Construction of an eight-inch water main and appurtenances from the intersection of the Bellevue-Redmond Road (AKA County Road No. 1387) west along N.E. 40th Street to the west line of sections 13 and 24, township 25 north, range 5 east, W.M., King County, Washington.

Section 2. The cost of the improvements shall be paid in whole or in part by the levy and collection of assessments upon the property specially benefited within the proposed improvement district in the manner provided by law, and such assessments shall be for the sole purpose of payment into such revenue bond fund as may be specified by the City Council for the Payment of revenue bonds issued to defray the cost of such improvements to the water system or any portion thereof.

Section 3. The Public Works Director and City Engineer are authorized and directed to prepare the preliminary estimates and assessment roll and certify the same to the City Council in the manner provided by RCW 35.43.130, to be filed with the City Clerk.

Section 4. The date of June 17 at the hour of 9.M., at the City Hall before the City Council is hereby set as the date, time and place for a public hearing on the Resolution and the City Clerk is directed to publish this Resolution and to cause proper notice of said hearing to be given in the manner and form required by law.
