

ORDINANCE NO. 2022

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF
REDMOND, WASHINGTON, SETTING
THE MAYOR'S SALARY AND CAR
ALLOWANCE

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Redmond has determined an increase is warranted in the salary to be paid the Mayor during the coming term; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council has directed to put into effect this year an increase in the car allowance paid to the Mayor for use of the Mayor's personal vehicle on City business; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON,
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. MAYOR'S SALARY. Effective January 1, 2000, the salary of the Mayor of Redmond shall be \$82,500 annually, payable in equal periodic installments according to the same pay schedule as other City employees.


Section 2. REPEALER. Ordinance 1835 of the City of Redmond setting the Mayor's salary for the current term and adopted by the City Council on May 16, 1995, is hereby repealed, effective January 1, 2000.

Section 3. CAR ALLOWANCE. Effective the month of April 1999, the car allowance paid monthly to the Mayor shall be \$375 per month.

Section 4. SEVERABILITY. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 5. This ordinance, being an administrative action, is not subject to referendum and shall take effect five days after publication of a summary thereof consisting of the title.


