ORDINANCE NO. 2036

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, RELATED TO INSTALLATION OF WATER METERS, MODIFICATION OF WATER SERVICE, INCREASING THE INSTALLATION CHARGE FOR WATER METERS, ADDING NEW SECTIONS TO CHAPTER 13.08 OF THE REDMOND MUNICIPAL CODE, AMENDING SECTION 13.08.030 OF THE REDMOND MUNICIPAL CODE, AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 13.08.030 of the Redmond Municipal Code establishes installation charges for water meters; and

WHEREAS, the City's water meter installation charges have not been updated since 1994; and

WHEREAS, the Utility Division of the Public Works Department has recommended that the charges be increased to reflect actual costs; and

WHEREAS, based upon the advice and recommendation of the Utility Division, the City Council has determined that it is in public interest to increase the City's water meter installation changes to reflect the true cost of such work; and

WHEREAS, City codes do not provide for recovery of City costs when installed water meters are modified; and

WHEREAS, existing City codes do not specify the manner in which water meters shall be installed in plats and other developments; NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DO  
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Installation Charges. Section 13.08.030 of the Redmond Municipal

Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

**13.08.030 Installation Charge.** An installation charge shall be paid by all persons connecting to the water system at the time of approval of an application for service. The charge shall be based upon the size of the water meter as follows:

Meter Size	Cost
5/8" x 3/4" drop-in	\$405.00
1 inch drop-in	465.00
1.5 inch drop-in	655.00
2 inch drop-in	785.00
3/4 inch full service	\$1,745.00
1 inch full service	1,960.00
1.5 inch full service	2,210.00, or actual cost, whichever is greater.
2 inch full service	2,400.00, or actual cost, whichever is greater.

Section 2. Full Service Installations. A new section 13.08.032 is hereby added to the Redmond Municipal Code to read as follows:

**13.08.032 Full Service Installations.** Full service installations shall only be constructed by the City only for single family residential structures on existing lots. Water service installations for all other developments (e.g., multifamily residential, commercial, industrial, and new residential plats and short plats) shall be constructed as part of the development improvements by the applicant or property owner.

Section 3. Water Service Modifications. A new section 13.08.035 is hereby added to the Redmond Municipal Code to read as follows:

**13.08.035 Water Service Modifications.** A charge shall be paid by all persons requesting a modification to their water service including adjustments of height, relocation, abandonment or other modifications. The charge shall be set by the City Engineer or his/her designee in an amount to cover the City's full cost for constructing such modification.

Section 4. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance, being an exercise of a power specifically delegated to the City legislative body, is not subject to referendum, and shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after passage and publication of an approved summary thereof consisting of the title.


