RESOLUTION NO. 204

A RESOLUTION, relating to and approving a Comprehensive Sewer Plan adopted by King County Water District 81 by its Resolution No. 197A, passed August 7, 1968.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of King County Water District 81 has requested approval by the City of Redmond of a Comprehensive Sewer Plan adopted by the District under its Resolution No. 197A, passed August 7, 1968, which amended a prior Plan by deleting certain areas rightfully belonging in the Redmond drainage basin; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Director has recommended that the City Council approve the amended Plan presented by the District, provided certain drainage areas be deleted, and the City Council has examined and has given due consideration to the Plan, Now, Therefore,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND as follows:

Section 1. The City of Redmond hereby approves the Comprehensive Sewer Plan adopted by the Board of Commissioners of King County Water District 81 by its Resolution No. 197A, passed August 7, 1968, provided, that the approval hereby given shall be subject to the provisos contained in Section 3 of Resolution No. 185, passed May 9, 1967 by the City of Redmond.


Section 2. This resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 12th day of November, 1968.


