

CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

RESOLUTION NO. 206

A RESOLUTION, relating to the location of a community swimming pool in the Redmond area by the King County Park Department from Forward Thrust Funds, and pledging the cooperation and support of the City of Redmond in making property available for a site.

WHEREAS, King County, through its Park Department, has developed a program for the location and construction of community swimming pools through funds made available from the proceeds of general obligation bonds by Forward Thrust, and is interested in developing a community swimming pool in the Redmond area on a site near the Redmond Senior High School; and

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond owns a forty-acre parcel of land adjacent to and immediately south of the Redmond Senior High School, which it plans to develop for park and recreational purposes, and the proposed community swimming pool would be a valuable addition to the proposed use of the property; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to cooperate with King County to make sufficient land available for a swimming pool site on the City-owned property, Now, Therefore,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND as follows:

1. The City of Redmond does hereby pledge its wholehearted support and cooperation to the King County Park Department in the location, development and construction of a community swimming pool in the Redmond area from Forward Thrust Funds, and does hereby urge that this worthwhile project be assigned high priority for an early completion.


2. The City of Redmond does hereby pledge to make available to King County without cost, an adequate site for the location and construction of a community swimming pool through Forward Thrust Funds upon the City-owned acreage adjacent to and immediately south of the Redmond Senior High School in Redmond, Washington, preferably on a long term lease arrangement.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 19 day of November, 1968.
