

ORDINANCE No. 21.

An Ordinance Prohibiting Minors from Playing at Games or Loitering about Pool or Billiard Rooms or Bowling Alleys and Fixing the Penalties therefor.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Redmond as follows:-

1. It shall be unlawful for any minor ^{Under the age of 18 yrs.} to play at any game of pool, billiards, bowling or cards, or any game whatsoever in any building operated as a pool or billiard room or bowling alley in the Town of Redmond, or to loiter about or be or remain in any such pool or billiard room or bowling alley.

2. Any minor ^{Under the age of 18 yrs.} so playing at any game as above stated or loitering about or being or remaining in any such pool or ^{or} billiard room, bowling alley, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not more than Ten Dollars.

3. Any proprietor or employee of any such pool or billiard room or bowling alley who shall permit any such minor ^{Under the age of 18 yrs.} to play at any game as above specified, or to loiter about, be or remain in any such pool or billiard room or bowling alley shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not more than Fifty Dollars.
