

## CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

RESOLUTION NO. 210

A RESOLUTION, declaring the intention of the City Council of the City of Redmond to order the formation of a local improvement district for the construction of street improvements on 166th Avenue N.E. extending from N.E. 80th Street to N.E. 104th Street; and fixing the date for a public hearing thereon.

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the City of Redmond and is necessary for the public peace, safety and welfare that 166th Avenue N.E., extending from N.E. 80th Street to N.E. 104th Street, within the city limits of Redmond, be improved by the construction of curbs, gutters, sidewalks, driveways across sidewalks, and necessary appurtenances thereto consistent with good street construction; and

WHEREAS, said street has been classified as a secondary city arterial [REDACTED] and the city intends to undertake the improvement of [REDACTED] of said street to a four-lane facility, forty-four feet (44') in width, curb to curb, as an Urban Arterial project and desires to provide for the construction of curbs, gutters, sidewalks and driveways across sidewalks at the same time; and

WHEREAS, the City Council having further determined that said improvements, except for the paved portion, should be paid in whole or in part by the levy and collection of assessments upon the property within the proposed improvement district; that a local improvement district should be formed for the construction of the improvement; and that a date for a public hearing thereon should be fixed, NOW THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby declares its intention to order the formation of a local improvement district for the construction of improvements upon 166th Avenue N.E., extending from N.E. 80th Street to

N.E. 104th Street, consisting of grading, retaining walls, if necessary, curbs, gutters, sidewalks, driveways across sidewalks, and necessary appurtenances consistent with good street construction.

Section 2. That the cost of the improvement be paid in whole or in part by the levy and collection of assessments upon the property specially benefited within the proposed improvement district in the manner provided by law; and that the special benefits conferred are such that the cost and expense of the improvement may be fairly apportioned thereon on a front footage basis, at the discretion of the City Council.

Section 3. That the description of the proposed local improvement district to be formed is attached hereto, entitled; "Legal Description of Proposed Local Improvement District for the Improvement of 166th Avenue N.E. from N.E. 80th Street to N.E. 104th Street" and is incorporated as a part of this resolution by reference thereto.

Section 4. That the Public Works Director and City Engineer be authorized and directed to prepare the preliminary estimates and assessment roll and certify the same to the City Council in the manner provided by RCW 35.43.130 to be filed with the City Clerk.

Section 5. That the date of FEBRUARY 16, 1969 at the hour of 8:00 P.M. at the City Hall before the City Council is hereby set as the time and place for a public hearing on the Resolution and the City Clerk is directed to publish this Resolution and to give proper notice of said hearing in the manner and form required by law.
