RESOLUTION NO. 212

A RESOLUTION, initiating procedures for the vacation of a portion of N.E. 70th Street; and fixing the time and place for a public hearing to be held thereon.

WHEREAS, a written request has been received by the City from property owners adjoining and abutting upon a portion of N.E. 70th Street within the City of Redmond, Washington, for the vacation of said street and public way; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that a public hearing should be set and held and that consideration should be given to determine whether or not the proposed vacation of street is in the public interest; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, as follows:

1. That the City Council does hereby declare its intention to consider the vacation of a portion of N.E. 70th Street, described as follows:

The north 30 feet of the west half of the southwest quarter of section 10, township 25 north, range 5 east, W.M.; Except the west 748.85 feet thereof.

Situated in the City of Redmond, King County, Washington.

and the public interest to be served by such vacation; and does hereby initiate procedures for the vacation of such street and public way.

2. That the date of March 4, 1969, at 8:00 P.M., at the City Hall, Redmond, Washington, before the City Council is hereby set as the date, time, place and authority for a public hearing to be held to consider the question of the vacation of such street and public way; and the City Clerk shall give due and proper notice of such hearing in the manner required by law.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 4 day of February, 1969.
