A RESOLUTION, authorizing the City to make application for and to contract for urban planning assistance grant for an estimated project cost of \$114,032. and designating the Mayor as the authorized official for the City.

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond desires to provide for a planning study contributing to an over-all program for future community development, the preservation of community values, the prevention of conditions tending to cause urban blight, and the promotion of the general health, safety and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Community Affairs Agency of the State of Washington, under authority of Chapter 74, Statutes 1967, Extraordinary Session, may provide planning assistance for such program and receive financial assistance from the Urban Renewal Administration, as authorized by Section 701 of the Housing Act of 1954, as amended; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, as follows:

1. That the City of Redmond hereby requests the Planning and Community Affairs Agency of the State of Washington to provide planning assistance under authority of Chapter 74, Statutes 1967, Extraordinary Session, with such financial assistance as may be provided by the Urban Renewal Administration, under authority of Section 701 of the Housing Act of 1954 (P.L. 860, 83rd Congress), as amended. That such planning assistance is more particularly described in a project description that is attached hereto and made a part of this resolution as if fully set forth herein.

Resolution No. 2/3 -

- 2. That, the City of Redmond, subject to approval of such planning assistance by the State and Federal authorities, hereby authorizes use of personnel of the City of Redmond for technical assistance in this project, which assistance has an estimated value of \$38,008.
- That, the total estimated cost of the City of Redmond's project as planned is \$114,032.
- That, the authorized official of the City of Redmond be the Mayor and he hereby is authorized and empowered to execute in the name of the City of Redmond all necessary contracts and agreements to implement and carry out the purposes specified in this resolution.
