RESOLUTION NO. 214

A RESOLUTION relating to the construction of public works and adopting standard specifications for municipal public work construction. (APWA Standard Specifications, 2nd Edition - 1969).

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond, Washington desires to construct its public works such as streets, sewers, water distribution systems, and other such facilities in accordance with the Standard Specifications for Municipal Public Works Construction of the Washington State Chapter of the American Public Works Association, 2nd Edition, published in 1969, Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND:

- l. That all public works construction, including but not limited to streets, sewers and water distribution systems, within or for the City of Redmond shall conform to the <u>Standard Specifications for Municipal Public Works Construction</u> of the Washington State Chapter of the American Public Works Association, 2nd Edition, published in 1969. <u>Provided, however</u>, that the Public Works Director may recommend supplemental specifications and/or special provisions as an amendment, modification or addition to said <u>Standard Specifications</u> for Municipal Public Works Construction which, after approval thereof by the City Council shall govern the performance of public works construction which may be affected thereby.
- 2. That Resolution No. 122, passed April 23, 1963 and Resolution No. 147, passed December 8, 1967, be and each is hereby rescinded and repealed, except that the minimum standards therein established shall continue to apply for public works construction

now in progress or for which contracts were let prior to the passage of this Resolution.
