CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

RESOLUTION NO. 2/6

A RESOLUTION, declaring certain real property of the waterworks utility to be surplus and authorizing its sale and transfer to the City general account for park purposes; and authorizing and directing the expenditure of \$40,000.00 of general obligation park bond funds.

WHEREAS, the waterworks utility of the City, including the system of sewerage as a part thereof, owns certain real property as hereafter described, containing approximately forty acres of unimproved land, which was acquired and used for purposes of protection of a municipal watershed; and

WHEREAS, the City has abandoned such watershed as a source of a municipal water supply and the purpose for which such real property was acquired, owned and maintained is no longer needed or necessary to the function of the waterworks utility and is not revenue-producing property of the utility; and

WHEREAS, such property is therefore no longer needed or required by the waterworks utility of the City and may be declared to be surplus property and sold or otherwise disposed of by the City; and

whereas, a portion of such property has heretofore been used and maintained for park and playground purposes by the City under a lease from the waterworks utility, and the City Council finds it is in the best interests of the citizens of Redmond and for the public peace, welfare and safety that such property be retained, developed and used for City park purposes; and

WHEREAS, the voters of the City on an election held November 8, 1966 approved a general obligation bond issue for park purposes, and it was then anticipated that a portion of such bond funds be used to acquire the property below described from the

waterworks utility to be transferred to the general account for park use, NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the following described real property:
The southwest quarter of the southeast quarter of section 36,
township 26 north, range 5 east W. M., situated in the City
of Redmond, King County, Washington,

is hereby found by the City Council to be no longer needed for any purpose of the waterworks utility and is not revenue producing property of the utility and the same may be and is hereby declared to be surplus property.

- 2. That the property described in paragraph 2 be and the same is hereby transferred from the waterworks utility of the City to the general account of the City for park purposes, to be used, developed, maintained and operated by the park department of the City for park, playground and other recreational uses.
- 3. That the City Treasurer and City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to disburse and transfer the sum of \$40,000.00 from the general obligation park bond fund to the waterworks utility (Water and Sewer Fund).
- 4. This resolution shall take effect and be in force upon its passage and approval.
