RESOLUTION NO. 218

A RESOLUTION, designating the Mayor as the authorized official to sign on behalf of the City in connection with federal grants and projects relating to waste treatment works and water pollution control.

WHEREAS, Section 8 of Public Law 84-660, provides for federal grants to municipalities on projects relating to water pollution control in waste treatment works; and

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond owns and operates a municipal sewerage utility and is in need of financial assistance and technical help in providing sewerage treatment works and expanding its system to meet increasing demands caused by population growth and commercial needs; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that an authorized official be designated to sign and represent the City in connection with applications and other necessary actions with respect to federal grants and assistance for its waste treatment works, Now, Therefore, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the Mayor, Selwyn L. Young, is hereby designated as the authorized official to sign and execute applications and other documents on behalf of the City of Redmond, Washington, in connection with federal grants and assistance under Section 8, Public Law 84-660, and other legislation, relating to water pollution control in waste treatment works; and that his signature shall be attested by the City Clerk.

2. That the Public Works Department shall determine and prepare necessary applications and other documents in connection with federal grants and assistance on projects relating to water pollution control in waste and sewerage treatment works; and shall advise the Mayor in connection therewith.
