

CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

RESOLUTION NO. 225

A RESOLUTION, authorizing application for funding assistance for an outdoor recreation project to the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation as provided by the Marine Recreation Land Act and the \$10,000,000 Outdoor Recreation Bond Issue of 1964.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Redmond has approved a "Comprehensive Park and Recreation Plan" for the urban area which identified a neighborhood park at the easterly city limits of the city as the number two priority.

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Marine Recreation Land Act, and the \$10,000,000 Outdoor Recreation Bond Issue of 1964 state and federal funding assistance has been authorized and made available to aid in financing the cost of land for parks and the construction of outdoor recreational facilities of local public bodies; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Redmond considered it in the best public interest to acquire a neighborhood park in the eastern part of the city generally located southwest of the intersection of Union Hill Road and 196th Avenue Northeast, and being intersected by Martin Creek;

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:


1. That the Mayor be authorized to make formal application to the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation for fund assistance;
2. That any fund assistance so received be used in the acquisition of five (5) acres of land in the eastern part of the City of Redmond, Washington;
3. That any property acquired with financial aid through the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation be placed in use as an outdoor recreation facility and be retained in such use in perpetuity unless as otherwise provided and agreed to by the City Council, the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation, and any affected federal

agency; and


4. That this resolution become part of a formal application to the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation.
