RESOLUTION NO. 229

A RESOLUTION, initiating procedures for the vacation of a portion of N.E. 70th Street; and fixing the time and place for a public hearing to be held thereon.

WHEREAS, a written request has been received by the City from property owners adjoining and abutting upon a portion of N.E. 70th Street within the City of Redmond, Washington, for the vacation of a part of said street and public way; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that a public hearing should be set and held to determine whether or not the proposed vacation of street is in the public interest; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, as follows:

1. That the City Council does hereby declare its intention to consider the vacation of a portion of N.E. 70th Street, described as follows:

That portion of unimproved Redmond Avenue (N. E. 70th Street) lying between the westerly margin of 140th Avenue N.E. and the centerline of the southwest quarter of section 10, township 25 north, range 5 east W.M., according to the plat of Keystone Addition to Kirkland, as recorded in volume 7 of plats, page 92, records of King County, Washington.

Situated in the City of Redmond, King County, Washington.

and the public interest to be served by such vacation; and does hereby initiate procedures for the vacation of such street and public way.

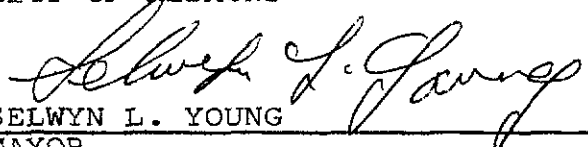
2. That the date of January 20, 1970, at 8:00 P.M., at the City Hall, Redmond, Washington, before the City Council is hereby set as the date, time, place and authority for a public hearing to be held to consider the question of the vacation of
