WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable and in the public interest that said Amendatory Grant Agreement be approved and its execution authorized, NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

- That the Amendatory Grant Agreement, a copy of which is hereto attached and made a part hereof by reference, be and the same is hereby approved without reservation or qualification.

AMENDATORY GRANT AGREEMENT

THIS AMENDATORY GRANT AGREEMENT, dated as of March 31, 1970, by and between the City of Redmond, Washington (herein called the "Applicant") and the United States of America, Secretary of Housing and Urban Development (herein called the "Government"), WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Grant Agreement between the Government and the Applicant dated March 12, 1970, provides a grant to the Applicant of \$153,800; and

WHEREAS, the Grant Agreement should reflect that the Government will make a Grant in an amount not to exceed \$153,800 or 50 percent of the Eligible Project Cost as determined by the Government on completion of the Project, whichever is the lesser, in order to aid in financing the Project hereinafter defined, presently estimated to cost \$611,300;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual benefits flowing to the Government and to the Applicant, said Grant Agreement is hereby amended as follows

In Section 1, Amount and Purpose, in line 3, insert the figure "50" in front of the word "percent".

THIS AMENDATORY GRANT AGREEMENT shall become effective as of the date hereof and all of the provisions of the original Grant Agreement, except as hereby amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
