RESOLUTION NO. 246

A RESOLUTION, authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute a lease on behalf of the City of Redmond with the Redmond Athletic Association in connection with the construction and operation of concession facilities on City park property for the "Little League" program.

WHEREAS, the Redmond Athletic Association has proposed to undertake at its expense, the construction and operation of concession facilities at the Little League baseball fields, located on the City's forty-acre park on N.E. 104th Street; and

WHEREAS, the Park Board has recommended that the City enter into a lease of the site for such facilities and the City Council finds it in the public interest to enter into such a lease, Now, Therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the City enter into a lease for a term of five years with the Redmond Athletic Association of a site for the construction and operation of concession facilities at the Little League baseball fields, located on the City's forty-acre park on N.E. 104th Street across from the Redmond Senior High School.

2. That the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized and empowered to execute such a lease on behalf of the City of Redmond, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 5th day of May, 1970.
