RESOLUTION NO. 247

A RESOLUTION, authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute a lease with King County for the construction and operation of a public swimming pool upon City park property.

WHEREAS, King County, by the use of Forward Thrust funds, is undertaking the construction of a public swimming pool upon a site located within the City's forty-acre park across from the Redmond Senior High School; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that King County obtain a long-term lease of the swimming pool site from the City of Redmond, Now, Therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the City of Redmond enter into lease of the following described property, which is a part of its forty-acre park located on N.E. 104th Street across from the Redmond Senior High School:

The north 360 feet of the east 412 feet of the southwest quarter of the southeast quarter of section 36, township 26 north, range 5 east, W.M., less roads and all convenient and necessary easements for utilities, ingress and egress; Also subject to an easement over and across the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter of said section 36, known as tax lot 14, King County, Washington.

Situated in the City of Redmond, King County, Washington.

for a term of forty years for the purpose of constructing and maintaining thereon an indoor public swimming pool.

Section 2. That the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized and empowered to execute such a lease on behalf of the City of Redmond.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 5th day of May, 1970.
