

CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

RESOLUTION NO. 257

A RESOLUTION, approving participation in the Federal Rent Supplement Program for a 41-unit apartment in the Viewpoint Area of the City of Redmond.

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Section 101 of the Housing and Urban Development Act of 1965, the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development is authorized to enter into contracts to make rent supplement payments to certain qualified housing owners on behalf of qualified low-income families who are elderly, handicapped, displaced, victims of natural disaster, or occupants of substandard housing; and

WHEREAS, the provisions of said Section 101 cannot be made available to housing owners in certain localities unless the governing body of the locality has by resolution given approval for such participation in the Federal Rent Supplement Program; and

WHEREAS, the owners of certain property in the Viewpoint Area of the City have requested such approval in connection with a 41-unit apartment and the City Council has determined that approval should be given; NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:


1. Approval is hereby granted for participation in the Federal Rent Supplement Program by qualified housing owners of property located in the Viewpoint Area of the City of Redmond in connection with a 41-unit apartment located thereon, such property being described as follows:

The north 343 feet of Tract C, re Platt of Tracts 1 and 2 of Harrison's Acreage Tracts, as per Platt recorded in Volume 19 of Platts, page 33, records of King County; situate in the city of Redmond, County of King, State of Washington

2. The approval hereby given is for the particular property described above and may not be considered or made applicable for any other location within the City.
