

CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

RESOLUTION NO. 259

A RESOLUTION, approving and confirming the filing of a petition before the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission for a declaratory ruling in connection with the reconstruction of the Redmond Way undercrossing of the Burlington-Northern Railroad through the Redmond Way Project (UAB Project No. 8-1-107(02)).

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond, in cooperation with the Urban Arterial Board (UAB Project No. 8-1-107(02)), the State Highway Department and King County (Forward Thrust Arterial Street Funds), is undertaking the improvement of an arterial street project upon a portion of Redmond Way (SR 901, Redmond Spur), extending from the Burlington-Northern Railroad undercrossing to an intersection with West Lake Sammamish Parkway N.E. (SR 901); and

WHEREAS, state law provides that the mayor and city council of a city may petition the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission for a declaratory ruling upon the alteration of an existing undercrossing to determine the design, method and manner of the reconstruction, the acquisition of additional right-of-way from the railroad, and the apportionment of the cost of the construction work; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has caused such a petition to be filed; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:


1. Pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 81.53 and Title 80 of the Revised Code of Washington, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Redmond hereby authorize and direct that the City Attorney prepare and file a petition with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission for a declaratory ruling upon reconstruction of the existing undercrossing of Redmond Way with the

Burlington-Northern Railroad in connection with the Redmond Way Project (UAB Project No. 8-1-107(02)), including the method, manner and design thereof, and the apportionment of construction costs.

2. The action of the Mayor in filing such a petition heretofore is hereby ratified and confirmed in all respects as the action of the Mayor and City Council of the City of Redmond.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 16 day of February, 1971.
