RESOLUTION NO. 260

A RESOLUTION, making a formal conditional award of contract in connection with the Viewpoint Sanitary Sewer Project 68-13.00-SS (ULID 70-SS-16).

WHEREAS, sealed bids have been received and opened in connection with the construction of sanitary sewer system improvements for the Viewpoint Sanitary Sewer Project 68-13.00-SS, which is also administered under City of Redmond Utility Local Improvement District No. 70-SS-16, U. S. Department of Housing & Urban Development Project No. WS-WASH-88, and Federal Water Pollution Control Administration Project WPC-WN-313, and the City desires to make an award of the construction contract to the companies submitting the lowest base bids, subject to the approval of the foregoing agencies, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

The construction contract for the Viewpoint Sanitary Sewer Project 68-13.00-SS is hereby awarded to the following companies who have submitted the lowest base bids, subject to the review and approval of the U. S. Department of Housing & Urban Development (Project No. WS-WASH-88) and the Federal Water Pollution Control Administration (Project No. WPC-WN-313):
