

CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

RESOLUTION NO. 267

A RESOLUTION, approving an agreement (Addendum No. 1) with Lake Hills Sewer District and empowering the Mayor and City Clerk to execute the same on behalf of the City of Redmond.

WHEREAS, Lake Hills Sewer District and the City of Redmond heretofore entered into a Joint Use and Transfer of Facilities Agreement, dated February 23, 1968, and the parties desire to amend such agreement to include an additional District facility for use by the City as a joint use general facility; and

WHEREAS, such agreement contemplated additional joint use facilities could be agreed upon by the parties and the City Council of Redmond having considered the proposed amendment of the agreement to be in the best interests of the City of Redmond and its sanitary sewer utility, Now, Therefore, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the City of Redmond enter into an agreement with Lake Hills Sewer District of King County, to be entitled "Addendum No. 1, Joint Use and Transfer of Facilities Agreement," to provide for an additional joint use general facility, described as follows:

12" trunk sewer line, extending from a point 315 feet east of Lake Hills Manhole #6 (ULID #9) to the Metro trunk facility at N.E. 16th Place and the Bellevue-Redmond Road, Bellevue, Washington.

The City of Redmond shall reimburse the District for its portion of the actual costs of such facility, estimated to be \$11,137.27.


2. That the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized and empowered to execute Addendum No. 1 to the agreement on behalf of the City of Redmond, subject to approval as to form by the City Attorney.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof, AND APPROVED by the Mayor Pro Tem this 6 day of April, 1971.
