RESOLUTION NO. 270

A RESOLUTION, endorsing the plan of the State Highway Department in connection with the completion of I-90 between the Factoria Interchange and I-5.

WHEREAS, the State Highway Department has prepared plans for the completion of Interstate Highway 90 between the Factoria Interchange and Interstate Highway 5 in Seattle, King County, Washington, to a ten-laned facility, including two lanes designed for future provision for rapid transit; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered such plans and deems them to be in the best interests of the City of Redmond, the area east of Lake Washington and the transportation and commerce needs of Seattle, King County, the State of Washington and nation; Now, Therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:


1. The City of Redmond does hereby endorse and support the plan of the State Highway Department for the completion of Interstate Highway 90 between the Factoria Interchange and Interstate Highway 5 in Seattle, Washington, to a ten-laned facility, including two lanes for future rapid transit facilities. This forms an important link in the Interstate Highway system and should be given early priority for the construction phase. This facility is vital to the commerce and transportation needs of this area, as well as serving the needs of the state, county and nation. The intersection of two major cross-country highways in a large metropolitan area emphasize the importance and scale of this highway structure. Present needs require immediate construction plans.

2. The City of Redmond expresses its confidence that the Washington State Highway Commission and Highway Department personnel


have planned and will continue to plan for and construct a safe and efficient highway system which will best serve the needs of transportation and commerce and will be satisfactory to the parties it serves.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 15th day of June, 1971.
