

CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

RESOLUTION NO. 274

A RESOLUTION, relating to collective bargaining; recognizing Newspaper and Magazine Drivers and Chauffeurs Local Union No. 763, IBT, as the exclusive bargaining representative for the Redmond Police Department; and authorizing the Mayor to engage in collective bargaining with such representative.

WHEREAS, the Newspaper and Magazine Drivers and Chauffeurs Local Union No. 763 of the International Brotherhood of Teamsters, filed a representative petition with the Department of Labor and Industries on August 16, 1971, certifying it represented a majority of the employees of the Police Department of the City of Redmond; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Labor and Industries thereafter, on September 9, 1971, issued its Certification of Representative, certifying that the Union had been designated and selected by a majority of the employees of the City of Redmond Police Department as the exclusive collective bargaining representative for such bargaining unit, Now, Therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO RESOLVE as follows:

1. That Newspaper and Magazine Drivers and Chauffeurs Local Union No. 763, IBT, is hereby recognized as the exclusive bargaining representative for the following bargaining unit of the City of Redmond:

Included: All regular full-time members of the City of Redmond Police Department classified as Sergeant; Detective/Sergeant; Detective; Patrolman; Police-woman; Clerk/Dispatcher.

Excluded: Chief of Police; Captain; Lieutenant; Members of the police Reserve; All other City of Redmond, Washington employees.


pursuant to RCW Chapter 41.56.

2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to engage in collective bargaining with the above designated bargaining

representative for those incidents of employment of the above indicated bargaining unit as provided for by RCW Chapter 41.56.
