RESOLUTION NO. 275

A RESOLUTION, expressing the appreciation and grateful thanks of the citizens of Redmond for the generous and thoughtful testamentary devise of approximately 70 acres by Elise Farrel McWhirter to the City of Redmond, for park and playground purposes.

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond has been advised by the attorneys for the Estate of Elise Farrel McWhirter, Deceased, that the decedent made a testamentary devise of approximately 70 acres of land to the City of Redmond for park and playground purposes, as follows:

"I devise to the City of Redmond, in King County, Washington, the real property and improvements thereon where I now reside, and including all of my real property at or adjacent to said residence, to be used for park and playground purposes. I request that the park be known as 'FARREL-McWHIRTER PARK,' as a memorial to my deceased husband and me."

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council wish to express the appreciation and grateful thanks of the City and its citizens for the foregoing testamentary devise, Now, Therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the City of Redmond and its citizens do hereby express their appreciation and grateful thanks for the most generous and thoughtful devise of approximately 70 acres of land for park and playground purposes by Elise Farrel McWhirter to the City of Redmond. The City does further pledge for itself and its citizens, both now and in the future, to utilize its effort and resources to justify the faith and confidence expressed in it by Mrs. McWhirter and to make "FARREL-McWHIRTER PARK" a fitting and lasting memorial to her and her deceased husband.

2. That certified copies of this Resolution be furnished to the nieces, nephews and next of kin of Elise Farrel McWhirter who are mentioned in her Last Will and Testament, to the co-executors of her Will, and to the attorneys for the estate.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 5th day of October, 1971.
