ORDINANCE NO. 2765**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, AMENDING RMC SECTIONS 3.58.010 AND 3.58.020 TO EXPAND THE DEFINITION OF REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES IN THE FUND, TO CHANGE THE NAME OF THE FUND, AND TO COMPLY WITH GOVERNMENTAL ACCOUNTING STANDARDS BOARD CODIFICATION OF GOVERNMENTAL ACCOUNTING AND FINANCIAL REPORTING STANDARDS

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 1058 established the Fire Department and Emergency Medical Services Equipment Fund to administer the use of donated money made to the Redmond Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond approved the creation of the Fire Department and Emergency Medical Services Equipment Fund on June 8, 1982; and

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond seeks to align the fund language with actual revenue collections within the fund and the appropriate use of expenditures; and

WHEREAS, the Governmental Accounting Standards Board (GASB) codification of governmental accounting and financial reporting standards require committed revenues are resources with limitations imposed by the highest level of government, and where the limitations can be removed only by a similar action of the same governing body; and

WHEREAS, the majority of support for the Fire Department and Emergency Medical Services Equipment Fund comes from telecom leases revenues and ambulance performance fees; and

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond seeks to rename the Fire Department and Emergency Medical Services Equipment Fund to the "Emergency Services Fund."

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become a part of the City Code.

Section 2. Amendment of Section. RMC Section 3.58.010, Fund Created, is hereby amended to read as follows:

3.58.010 Fund Created. There is hereby created a special revenue fund known as the "[~~FIRE DEPARTMENT AND~~] Emergency [~~MEDICAL~~] Services [~~EQUIPMENT~~] Fund" into which telecom leases, ambulance response penalties, and all donations of money intended for the use of the Redmond Fire Department shall be deposited.

Section 3. Amendment of Section. RMC Section 3.58.020, Purposes - Expenditures, is hereby amended to read as follows:

3.58.020 Purposes - Expenditures. The fund has been established for the purpose of accumulating funds for


the acquisition, maintenance and repair of [~~A MEDICAL
EMERGENCY AID CAR AND OTHER FIRE DEPARTMENT~~] emergency
equipment and supplies which would benefit department
safety efforts. The monies deposited into the [~~FIRE
DEPARTMENT~~—AND] Emergency [~~MEDICAL~~] Services
[~~EQUIPMENT~~] Fund shall be expended only for such
purposes and for no other purpose unless otherwise
directed by ordinance of the City Council.

Section 4. Severability. If any section, sentence,
clause, or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid
or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such
invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity
of any other section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this
ordinance.

Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take
effect five days after its publication, or publication of a
summary thereof, in the City's official newspaper, or as
otherwise provided by law.




