city of redmond, washington resolution no. 278

A RESOLUTION, authorizing application for funding assistance for an outdoor recreation project to the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation as provided by the Marine Recreation Land Act and the \$40,000,000 Outdoor Recreation Bond Issue of 1968.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, has approved a "Comprehensive Park and Recreation Plan" for the urban area of Redmond, which identifies a neighborhood park located at 7802 - 168th Avenue N.E. in the central part of the city as the number two priority; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Marine Recreation Land Act and the \$40,000,000 Outdoor Recreation Bond Issue of 1968, state and federal funding assistance has been authorized and made available to aid in financing the cost of land for parks and the construction of outdoor recreational facilities of local public bodies; and

WHEREAS, the City Council considers it in the best public interest to develop a neighborhood park in the central part of the city located at 7802 - 168th Avenue N.E. and to make application for state and federal funding assistance; Now, Therefore, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Application authorized. That the mayor be

authorized to make formal application to the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation for fund assistance in connection with the development of a park at 7802 - 168th Avenue N.E., Redmond, Washington.

Section 2. <u>Use of fund assistance</u>. That any fund assistance so received be used in the development of approximately three (3) acres of land in the central part of the City of Redmond.

Section 3. <u>Future park use assured.</u> That any property developed with financial aid through the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation be placed in the use as an outdoor recreation facility and be retained in such use in perpetuity unless as otherwise provided and agreed to by the City Council, the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation, and any affected federal agency.

Section 4. Resolution made part of application. That this resolution become part of a formal application to the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 19th day of October , 1971.
