RESOLUTION NO. 279

A RESOLUTION, approving an engineering study report by Futrell Incorporated for street improvements in conjunction with the federal TOPICS program.

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond entered into an agreement with Futrell Incorporated, consulting engineers, on March 15, 1971, to undertake an engineering study for the City in cooperation with the U. S. Department of Transportation, the Federal Highway Administration and the Washington State Highway Commission, under the federally sponsored Traffic Operations Program to Increase Capacity and Safety (TOPICS), to make recommendations for needed improvements to increase the safe and expeditious movement of vehicular and pedestrian traffic upon certain qualifying streets of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the TOPICS Report submitted by the consulting engineers under City Project No. 71-ST-91 in September, 1971, and deems that the same should be approved and adopted to implement needed street improvements involving traffic safety and movement under the TOPICS program, Now, Therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:


1. That the engineering study report submitted in September, 1971, by Futrell Incorporated, Consulting Engineers, under City of Redmond Project No. 71-ST-91, in cooperation with the U. S. Department of Transportation, the Federal Highway Administration and the Washington State Highway Commission pursuant to the federally sponsored TOPICS program, is hereby approved and adopted for the

purposes therein indicated subject to appropriate revision by the agencies involved to carry out the program.

2. That the Director of Public Works is hereby authorized and directed to prepare the necessary applications for obtaining funding assistance and approval by the agencies involved to implement the approved TOPICS program for Redmond and to otherwise administer and carry out the program on behalf of the City.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 19th day of October, 1971.


