

ORDINANCE #28.

An Ordinance Amending Certain Sections Of Ordinances Numbered Eighteen and Twenty-five, Fixing Prices For The Installation Of Water, The Rates To Be Charged For Water, And The Hours For Sprinkling And Irrigating.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF REDMOND AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I.

That Section Number Two of Ordinance Number Eighteen be amended to read as follows: "The fee for the installation of water service herein-before provided shall be the exact cost of said installation instead of a flat rate heretofore charged".

SECTION II.

That Section Number Three of Ordinance Number Eighteen be amended to read as follows: "The monthly rates for the use of water shall be a flat one of \$1.50 per month, which shall include the use of water for either domestic or commercial purposes".

SECTION III.

That Section Number One of Ordinance Number Twenty-five be amended to read as follows: "All water users of the Town of Redmond shall have the privilege of using city water for sprinkling and irrigating lawns and gardens from six o'clock to eight o'clock in the forenoon, and from seven to eight-thirty o'clock in the afternoon, only.
