RESOLUTION NO. 281

A RESOLUTION, relating to solid waste management and confirming the intent and desire of the City of Redmond to enter into an agreement with King County to prepare a joint city-county plan for such purposes.

WHEREAS, RCW Chapter 70.95 requires each county within the State of Washington to prepare a coordinated, comprehensive solid waste management plan in cooperation with the various cities located within the county; and requires each city to select an option for its participation in the plan; and

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond has previously indicated to King County its desire to jointly prepare a plan with King

County and now desires to confirm

such an agreement, Now, Therefore,

THE BOARD OF REDMOND DO RESOLVE as follows:

Option 1. In accordance with RCW 70.95.010, the City of Redmond does hereby select the following

option in a comprehensive solid waste management plan with King County:

That the City of Redmond shall: 1. Enter into an agreement with the county in which the City shall participate in a joint city-county plan for solid waste management.

2. Confirm its intent to enter into agreement. The City of Redmond affirms its intent and desire to enter into such an agreement with King County, Washington, for participation in

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond has previously indicated to King County its desire to jointly prepare a plan with King County for solid waste management and now desires to confirm its intent to enter into such an agreement, Now, Therefore, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO RESOLVE as follows:

1. Selection of option. In accordance with RCW 70.95.080, the City of Redmond does hereby select the following option for its participation in a comprehensive solid waste management plan with King County:

The City of Redmond shall:


"(2) Enter into an agreement with the county pursuant to which the City shall participate in preparing a joint city-county plan for solid waste management"

2. Confirmation of intent to enter into agreement. The City does hereby re-confirm its intent and desire to enter into an agreement with King County, Washington, for participation in

a comprehensive solid waste management plan on a joint city-county basis in keeping with previous correspondence between the City and King County.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 7 day of November, 1971.
