

CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

RESOLUTION NO. 282

A RESOLUTION, declaring the intent of the City of Redmond to annex an island of unincorporated territory and to set the date and time for a public hearing thereon.

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond is a non-charter code city of the State of Washington located within King County, with all of the rights, powers and privileges vested in code cities under RCW Title 35A, including the authority to annex territory pursuant to RCW Chapter 35A.14 as well as the general laws applicable to cities and towns of the State of Washington; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined such territory should be annexed to the City of Redmond pursuant to RCW 35A.14.295-299 in order to make possible necessary municipal services to such territory, to reduce irregular boundaries and to eliminate isolated islands of incorporated territory, Now, Therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the following described unincorporated territory should be annexed to the City of Redmond:

The southwest quarter of the southwest quarter of the southwest quarter of Section 23, Township 25N, Range 5E, W.M., situated in the County of King, State of Washington; less the south 30 feet and west 30 feet of the above described property.


2. That, as nearly as may be, the number of voters residing within the territory described above is none.

3. That the territory described above consists of 9.07 acres, having an assessed valuation of \$106,000, and is totally surrounded by the corporate limits of the City of Redmond so that at least eighty percent of the boundaries of such territory are contiguous to the City.

4. That December 7, 1971, at 8:00 P.M., at the City Hall before the City Council is hereby set as the date, time and place for a public hearing on this resolution.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor, this 16 day of November, 1971.
