

CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

RESOLUTION NO. 286

A RESOLUTION, relating to the improvement of Jonathon E. Hartman Park through a grant from the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation of the State of Washington; approving a Project Agreement between the City and the Committee; and authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute such agreement on behalf of the City of Redmond.

WHEREAS, the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation of the State of Washington has approved a grant funds to assist in the development and improvement of Jonathon E. Hartman Park for an estimated project cost of \$218,847, of which the Interagency Committee would pay \$164,135.25 or 75% of the total project cost, whichever is less; and

WHEREAS, the Interagency Committee has submitted a Project Agreement for approval and execution by the City of Redmond for the foregoing purposes; and

WHEREAS, the City Council deems it in the public interest and for the public welfare that such Project Agreement be entered into by the City of Redmond and that the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized and empowered to execute such Agreement on behalf of the City; Now, Therefore,


THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

1. Project Agreement with IAC Approved. That certain Project Agreement signed on December 22, 1971, by Stanley E. Francis, Administrator, on behalf of the State of Washington Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation for the development and improvement of Jonathon E. Hartman Park is hereby approved and accepted by the City of Redmond.

2. Mayor and City Clerk authorized to execute Agreement. The Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized and empowered to execute such Project Agreement on behalf of the City of Redmond in as many counterparts as are necessary.


