RESOLUTION NO. 288

A RESOLUTION, accepting full responsibility for the security, maintenance and operation of the Farrel-McWhirter Park.

WHEREAS, Elise Farrel McWhirter, deceased, has made a testamentary devise of approximately 70 acres of land to the City of Redmond for park and playground purposes and her Will is currently being probated in the Superior Court of the State of Washington for King County under cause no. E-208331, and

WHEREAS, it appears it may be some time before the estate is finally closed and the executors for the estate now desire to transfer possession of the property to the City and have requested the City to assume all responsibilities and risk of loss in connection with said premises prior to the actual closing of the estate; and the City Council, deeming such request to be meritorious and should be accepted, Now, Therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the City of Redmond does hereby accept the transfer of possession of the following described real property devised to it by Elise Farrel McWhirter, deceased, in accordance with her Last Will and Testament and Codicils thereto, which have been filed for probate in the Superior Court of the State of Washington for King County under cause No. E-208331, to wit:

Southeast quarter of Northeast quarter, except the West 30 feet and except roads, and the Northeast quarter of the Southeast quarter, except West 30 feet and except roads, of Section 31, Township 26 North, Range 6, E.W.M., situate in King County, State of Washington. EXCEPT the following: The North 200 feet of the Southeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 31, Township 26 North, Range 6, E.W.M., less the West 30 feet thereof.

And the City of Redmond does hereby assume full responsibility and liability with respect to such property and the maintenance and operation thereof, including without limitation, the security of the premises, all risk of loss, all obligations for taxes, if any, and any and all liability for injury to or death of persons or damage to property in connection with or applicable to the premises described above.


2. That the effective date for the transfer of the possession of said property and assumption of responsibility and liability in connection therewith shall be the date of March 6, 1972, in accordance with the request of the executors of the estate of Elise F. McWhirter, deceased.

3. That the City Clerk shall provide a sufficient number of certified copies of this Resolution as may be required for the purposes of the estate proceedings.
