THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:



PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 6th day of June, 1972.


