

CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

RESOLUTION NO. 300

A RESOLUTION, declaring the intent of the City of Redmond to annex an island of unincorporated territory and to set the date and time for a public hearing thereon.

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond is a non-charter code city of the State of Washington located within King County, with all of the rights, powers and privileges vested in code cities under RCW Title 35A, including the authority to annex territory pursuant to RCW Chapter 35A.14 as well as the general laws applicable to cities and towns of the State of Washington; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined the following described territory should be annexed to the City of Redmond pursuant to RCW 35A.14.295-299 in order to make possible necessary municipal services to such territory, to reduce irregular boundaries and to eliminate isolated islands of incorporated territory, Now, Therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

1. Description. That the following described unincorporated territory should be annexed to the City of Redmond:

That portion lying in the southeast quarter of section 10, township 25 north, range 5 east, W.M., King County, Washington, described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the north line of said southeast quarter, which is 1493.73 feet west of the northeast corner of said southeast quarter; thence southerly at right angles to said north line of the southeast quarter to the centerline of state aid road No. 4 (Aka Collins Road No. 850 and Old Redmond Road); thence, westerly along the centerline of state aid road No. 4 to a line 708.23 feet east of, measured at right angles, and parallel to, the west line of said southeast quarter; Thence southerly along said line 708.23 feet east of the west line of the southeast quarter to the north line of the south half of said southeast quarter; thence westerly along said north line of the south half of the southeast quarter to a line 1870 feet west of, measured at right angles, and parallel to, the east line of said southeast quarter; thence southerly along said line 1870 feet west of the east line of the southeast quarter to the north line of the south 912 feet of said southeast quarter; thence westerly along said north line of the south 912 feet of the southeast quarter to the west line of said southeast quarter; thence northerly along said west line of the southeast quarter to the westerly extension of the northern margin of state aid Road No. 4; thence easterly along said extension and northerly margin of state aid road No. 4 to a line 334 feet east of, measured at right angles, and parallel to, said west line of the southeast quarter; thence northerly along said 334 feet east of said west line of the southeast quarter to the said north line of the southeast quarter; thence easterly along said north line of the southeast quarter to a point

1493.73 west of said northeast corner of the south-east quarter and the point of beginning.
All situated in King County, Washington.


2. Number of voters. That, as nearly as may be, the number of voters residing within the territory described above is 15.

3. Island of unincorporated territory - size - assessed valuation. That the territory described above consists of 25.93 acres, having an assessed valuation of \$85,560, and is totally surrounded by the corporate limits of the City of Redmond so that at least eighty percent (80%) of the boundaries of such territory are contiguous to the City.

4. Hearing date set. That July 18, 1972, at 8:00 P.M., at the City Hall before the City Council is hereby set as the date, time and place for a public hearing on this resolution.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 20th day of June, 1972.
