RESOLUTION NO. 302

A RESOLUTION, relating to streets and highways and approving the establishment of grades by the State Highway Commission on SR 901 (West Lake Sammamish Parkway N.E.), within the city limits of Redmond from SR 90 to the Redmond Spur.

WHEREAS, the State Department of Highways has presented to the City of Redmond a set of plans showing the proposed grade elevations on sign route 901 (West Lake Sammamish Parkway N.E.) within the corporate limits of Redmond, and has requested approval of such grades; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works has reviewed the proposed grade elevations, has requested certain changes, and now recommends the approval of such established grade elevations in accordance with the correspondence between the parties, NOW, THEREFORE,


THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

1. Grade elevations approved. That the grade elevations on sign route 901 (West Lake Sammamish Parkway N.E.) within the corporate limits of the City of Redmond, extending from SR 90 to the Redmond Spur, as shown on sheets 1 through 45 of 45 sheets of the plans entitled "SR 90 to Redmond Spur-Drainage and Shoulder Widening" and which bear the approval of the Assistant Director for Highway Development dated July 24, 1972, be and the same are hereby approved.

2. Effective date of approval. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
