RESOLUTION NO. 325

A RESOLUTION, authorizing and empowering the Mayor and City Attorney to sign and participate in the filing of a petition for the dissolution of Water District No. 99.

WHEREAS, the Cities of Bellevue and Redmond, together with King County Water District No. 99, jointly entered into a contract on November 7, 1972, pursuant to Chapter 95, Laws of 1971, 1st Ex. Sess., to provide for the assumption of the responsibility of Water District No. 99 for providing water service to the customers within its area and to purchase the facilities of such district and providing for the protection of the interest of the bondholders and creditors of the District, which contract was authorized by City of Redmond Resolution No. 308; and

WHEREAS, a due and proper notice of intention relative to the dissolution of the boundaries of the District and the assumption of its duties and responsibilities was filed with the King County Boundary Review Board on February 15, 1973 and was deemed approved by such Board on August 16, 1973, pursuant to RCW 36.93.100; and

WHEREAS, the transfers of the facilities and the assumption of the responsibilities in accordance with the Tripartite Agreement was accomplished on May 31, 1973, the transfer date agreed to; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate and necessary that there be a court determination declaring that all the property of the Water District, except bond funds, has been duly and lawfully transferred to the Cities of Bellevue and Redmond, respectfully, and further declaring that all the obligations of the Water District have been assumed by the City of Bellevue with respect to bondholders, and to dissolve Water District No. 99, King County, Washington, NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That Selwyn L. Young, Mayor of the City of Redmond, and John D. Lawson, City Attorney for Redmond, be authorized and empowered to execute and sign the Verified Petition for Dissolution of King County Water District No. 99 and to participate in such further proceedings as may be necessary or appropriate in connection with such proceedings.
- 2. That the City Clerk prepare and make available an appropriate number of certified copies of this Resolution as may be required in connection with such court proceedings.
