RESOLUTION NO. 327

A RESOLUTION, authorizing and approving an application for funding assistance to the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation as provided by the Marine Recreation Land Act for a project known as the Grass Lawn Ranch park property acquisition.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, has approved a "Comprehensive Park and Recreation Plan" for the urban area which identifies a community park in an area fronting on 148th Avenue N.E. and N.E. 70th Street, Redmond Washington; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Marine Recreation Land Act, state and federal funding assistance has been authorized and made available to aid in financing the cost of land for parks and the construction of outdoor recreational facilities of local public bodies; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, considers it in the best public interest to acquire a community park in the western part of the City generally located at 148th Avenue N.E. and N.E. 70th Street, Redmond, Washington, upon a site known as the Grass Lawn Ranch property; Now, Therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Application for fund assistance be approved. That an application be approved and the mayor is hereby authorized to make formal application to the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation for fund assistance in connection with a project known as the Grass Lawn Ranch park property acquisition.
- 2. <u>Use of fund assistance</u>. That any fund assistance so recevied be used in the acquisition of 28.5 acres of land in the western park of the City of Redmond, Washington, generally located at 148th Avenue N.E. and N.E. 70th Street.
- 3. Property acquired to be used as outdoor recreation facility. That any property acquired with financial aid through the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation be placed in use as an outdoor recreation facility and be retained in such use in perpetuity unless as otherwise provided and agreed to by the City Council, the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation, and any affected federal agency.
- 4. Resolution part of formal application. That this resolution become part of a formal application to the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation.
