

CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

RESOLUTION NO. 334

A RESOLUTION, declaring certain vehicles of the Equipment Rental Fund and the Fire Department to be surplus property; providing for the sale of such vehicles by sealed bid; and providing for the transfer of a vehicle from the Equipment Rental Fund to the Fire Department.

WHEREAS, the Equipment Rental Fund of the City of Redmond is charged with the responsibility of purchasing and maintaining vehicles for the use of other departments of the City and when replacement vehicles were purchased by the Equipment Rental Fund pursuant to public bid and as approved by the 1974 budget, the used car market was such that it was then recommended that trade-in not be included because of the low prices prevailing; and

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond through its Equipment Rental Fund and Fire Department is now ready to dispose of these vehicles through public bid and the City Council has determined that such vehicles should be declared surplus property and disposed of through public bid; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Department desires to obtain a vehicle through transfer from the Equipment Rental Fund and the City Council has determined that such transfer should be authorized and approved, Now, Therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the following described vehicles of the Equipment Rental Fund and of the Fire Department are hereby declared to be surplus property, to wit:

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
2. That the Director of Public Works is hereby authorized to advertise such vehicles for sale upon sealed public bids for the same or through such other public sale or auction as may be appropriate.
