RESOLUTION NO. 336

A RESOLUTION, fixing the date, time and place for a public hearing to be held before the City Council upon a Petition for the Vacation of a portion of 150th Avenue N.E.

WHEREAS, a written Petition for Vacation of Street has been filed with the City and presented to the City Council April 16, 1974, requesting that the City Council vacate that certain street and public way lying within the limits of the City of Redmond, described as follows:

The following portion of 150th Avenue N.E.:


The easterly and westerly 10 feet of the right-of-way of 150th Avenue N.E., in the plat of Overlake Industrial Park No. 2 as recorded in volume 66, pages 52, 53 & 54, records of King County, Washington, lying in the northwest quarter of section 23, township 25, range 5 east, W.M., between a line 80 feet northerly of and parallel to the centerline of N.E. 36th Street and a line 80 feet southerly of and parallel to the centerline of N.E. 40th Street, said 40th Street centerline also being the northerly margin of said northwest quarter section

Situate in the City of Redmond, King County, Washington.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the date of May 7, 1974, at the hour of 8:00 P.M., is hereby fixed as the date and time for a public hearing on said Petition for Vacation of Street, to be held at the City Hall before the City Council; and that the City Clerk give due and proper notice of such hearing in the manner required by law.
