## city of redmond, washington resolution no. 337

A RESOLUTION, fixing the date, time and place for a public hearing to be held before the City Council upon a Petition for the Vacation of a portion of N.E. 80th Street.

WHEREAS, a written Petition for Vacation of Street has been filed with the City and presented to the City Council May 7, 1974, requesting that the City Council vacate that certain street and public way lying within the limits of the City of Redmond, described as follows:

The following portion of N.E. 80th Street:

Commencing at the north 1/4 corner of section 10, township 25 north, range 5 east, W.M., said point being further described as lying at the centerline intersection of N.E. 80th Street and 140th Avenue N.E.; thence south 87°09'00" east, 312.66 feet, along the centerline of said N.E. 80th Street, to a point of curvature to the left; thence south 2°51'00" west, 30.00 feet to the southerly margin of said N.E. 80th Street, a point of curvature to the left, and the true point of beginning; thence along said curve to the left, having a radius of 130.00 feet, through a central angle of 39°42'54", along an arc length of 90.11 feet to a point on curve; thence south 87°09'00" east, 84.65 feet to the southerly margin of SR 901; thence south 49°58'13" east, 49.64 feet, along said southerly margin; thence north 87°09'00" west, 207.26 feet to the true point of beginning.

Situate in the City of Redmond, King County, Washington.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the date of June 4, 1974, at the hour of 8:00 P.M., is hereby fixed as the date and time for a public hearing on said Petition for Vacation of Street, to be held at the City Hall before the City Council; and that the City Clerk give due and proper notice of such hearing in the manner required by law.
