RESOLUTION NO. 338

A RESOLUTION, relating to employment; providing for the continued employment of Edward Sullivan past the age of seventy; and authorizing an application to the Public Employees' Retirement Board.

WHEREAS, Edward Sullivan has been employed by the City of Redmond as a Construction Inspector and is possessed of special skills in the performance of such duties; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Sullivan will reach the age of seventy on July 26, 1974, and has requested that he be continued in employment in the capacity as Construction Inspector; and the Director of Public Works has recommended that he be continued in such employment; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that an application be made to the Public Employees' Retirement Board for continued service and that the City Council approve such application by resolution, NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Edward Sullivan be continued in employment as a Construction Inspector for the City of Redmond past the age of seventy for an indefinite period of time subject to his continued fitness for such employment as determined by the Director of Public Works.

2. That the Director of Public Works be authorized to prepare and process with the required signatures thereto, an application to the Public Employees' Retirement Board for the continued service of such employee under the Retirement Act.
