A RESOLUTION, setting the date for a special election to be held within the City of Redmond, Washington, to consider the recall of Mayor Selwyn L. Young.


WHEREAS, the King County Superintendent of Elections has certified by letter dated January 3, 1975, that there were sufficient signatures upon recall petitions filed with his office to meet the requirements of RCW Chapter 29.82 for calling a special election before the registered voters of the City of Redmond, Washington, to consider the recall of Mayor Selwyn L. Young; Now, Therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

1. Date for special recall election set. That the date of March 4, 1975, is hereby set and established as the date for a special election to be held within the city limits of the City of Redmond, Washington, to consider the recall of Mayor Selwyn L. Young as provided by law.


