A RESOLUTION, setting the date for a special election to be held within the City of Redmond, Washington, to consider the recall of Councilman Sid Hulo.

WHEREAS, the King County Superintendent of Elections has certified by letter dated February 14, 1975, that there were sufficient signatures upon recall petitions filed with his office to meet the requirements of RCW Chapter 29.82 for calling a special election before the registered voters of the City of Redmond, Washington, to consider the recall of Councilman Sid Hulo; Now, Therefore,


THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

1. Date for special recall set. That the date of April 8, 1975, is hereby set and established as the date for a special election to be held within the city limits of the City of Redmond, Washington, to consider the recall of Councilman Sid Hulo as provided by law.

2. Copies of resolution to be furnished. That the City Clerk shall prepare certified copies of this resolution and cause the same to be filed with the Superintendent of Elections of King County, Washington.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 18th day of February, 1975.


