RESOLUTION NO. 374

A RESOLUTION accepting a deed to property on
148th Avenue N.E. for fire department purposes.

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond Fire Department and King County Fire District #34 are parties to a mutual aid agreement for fire fighting purposes whereby the City of Redmond Fire Department in cooperation with King County Fire District #34 renders fire protection and fire fighting services to properties located within the City limits of Redmond and within the limits of King County Fire District #34; and

WHEREAS, King County Fire District #34 has owned real property at a fire station on 148th Avenue N.E. at an address location of 4211 - 148th Avenue N.E., Redmond, Washington 98052, which property had been annexed by the City of Bellevue and became property of Bellevue under the annexation laws then in effect; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue has always recognized and has acknowledged this property to be property essential for the use of the City of Redmond Fire Department and King County Fire District #34 for fire protection and fire fighting purposes and has executed a Quitclaim Deed, conveying any right, title and interest of the City of Bellevue to such property to the City of Redmond and King County Fire District #34; and


WHEREAS, the City of Redmond is in the process of acquiring additional property towards enlarging the fire station facility and the City Council has determined that the Quitclaim Deed and conveyance should be accepted on behalf of the City of Redmond, Now, Therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the Quitclaim Deed by the City of Bellevue to the City of Redmond and the King County Fire District #34, conveying property located at 4211 - 148th Avenue N.E., Redmond, King County, Washington, be accepted on behalf of the City of Redmond.
2. That the subject deed be duly recorded and that the property and facilities be utilized by the City of Redmond Fire Department as may be determined appropriate for fire protection and fire fighting purposes.
