

CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

RESOLUTION NO. 378

A RESOLUTION opposing the relocation or realignment of school district boundaries to place the Audubon Elementary School within the Bellevue School District.

WHEREAS, a petition has been circulating which requests a change in the school district boundary line for the Audubon Elementary School to place this enrollment within the Bellevue School District rather than within the Lake Washington School District within which territory the school is presently situated; and


WHEREAS, this area of the City has been showing a shift to identify more with the Redmond community than Bellevue, and the shift of school district boundaries with respect to this elementary school could serve to seriously jeopardize and interfere with the community identification of the citizens of the area; and


WHEREAS, there further exists a concern that the recent failure of the excess levy by the Lake Washington School District may have precipitated the circulation of the petition for a change in the boundary line for this elementary school, and the success or failure of school bond levy elections is not a valid reason or basis for changing school district boundaries and such effort should be discouraged; NOW, THEREFORE,


THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the City of Redmond does strongly oppose any change in the school district boundary lines which would have the effect of placing the Audubon Elementary School within the Bellevue School District instead of the Lake Washington School District in which it is presently situated.
2. That the City of Redmond, the residents of the area concerned, and the Lake Washington School District be encouraged to join together and cooperate in seeking more adequate means of financing costs of education through State revenues.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 1 day of July, 1975.
